Mission Hill in Harmony, 20th Anniversary

January 1, 2010

On October 23, 2009, the Harmony On The Hill initiative hosted its first event by marking the twentieth anniversary of the Carol DiMaiti Stuart tragedy and its racially charged aftermath with an informative and thought provoking opening evening at the Tobin Community Center in Mission Hill. The program attracted approximately 300 participants – a diverse group ranging from young children to seniors - and received significant media coverage

Harmony On The Hill will continue its year long initiative with additional events planned by the Mission Hill community and based on neighborhood consensus which may include activities such as race relations symposia, fundraising events to support scholarships for Mission Hill youth and police-community relations workshops. Finally, in 2010, there will be a 20th anniversary Mission Hill in Harmony concert to be held, once again, at the Mission Church.

Vital to the success of this initiative is your support for the ongoing community process by which we will identify issues and develop specific events. We are seeking your financial assistance to help us organize and host the neighborhood workshop which will shape our program and the events and concert that will follow.
